Construction on the trail itself is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2020, but we can expect access to our beach from the parking lot to be restricted at some point this summer as they work on the project. In 2018, the Inglewood Beach Club had 107 current members and 12 guest members.

Last year we voted to utilize funds for quarterly regular landscaping maintenance to help with continuous cleanup including slow removal of the downed tree (please feel welcome to help with this removal process as you can too). We have various general maintenance costs upcoming for replacement of chairs, swim line, raft ladder, etc. Additionally, we continue to maintain a reserve of funds for the lock replacement and further enhancements to the property once the trail is finished.

Parking along E. Lake Sammamish Pkwy. is very limited and with the ongoing construction of the trail we need to maximize the number of parking spaces. Please park at an angle when possible while keeping any driveways/gates clear.


